COVID-19 Rules

Based on COVID Reopening Guidelines Issued by State of NH January 12, 2021.

The health and well-being of our employees and camping guests is our priority, and we realize that you are depending on us to manage the campground in a manner to keep you safe, while allowing you the freedom to enjoy the beautiful facilities at Silver Lake Park Campground. In order to provide the best experience and to meet the COVID-19 guidelines issued by the State of New Hampshire, we have implemented this document of COVID-19 Rules to inform you of our operational changes.

Silver Lake Park Campground & Cabins will be open to all of our seasonal campers or transient campers/cabins who are residents of New England states. Non-New England residents who have met the 10-day quarantine requirement who sign the following statement are also eligible for admission to the campground.

"I affirm that all the person(s) staying at Silver Lake Park Campground who are not residents of a New England state have remained at a home for at least 10 days before arriving in New Hampshire, only going out for essential items and when outside of the home maintaining social distancing and wearing face masks when within less than 6 feet of another person during this 10 day "quarantine". Everyone in my party is feeling well today and to our knowledge have not been exposed to someone with COVID-19."

NOTE: You do NOT need to quarantine for 10 days or get tested for COVID-19 if either of the following apply:

- You are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and more than 14 days have passed since you received the second dose of your COVID-19 vaccine.
- You have previously tested positive for active COVID-19 infection (by PCR or antigen testing) in the last 90 days (if you had a previous infection that was more than 90 days ago, you must still follow all quarantine requirements)

Visitors are allowed at campsites. New England Residents must sign-in. Non-New England visitors must sign-in and sign a document that includes the statement above.

Check-in:

- If anyone in your party is feeling sick or may have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus in the past 10 days they are to stay at home.
- At check-in the responsible party will be asked if anyone is feeling sick or may have been exposed to the COVID-19 virus, if someone does not feel well or has been exposed the entire party may not enter the campground.
- A reminder that the guidelines state that everyone needs to practice social distancing, frequent hand washing, and the use of cloth face coverings.

The following facilities will be open:

Outdoor public gathering areas including the beach, horse shoe, corn hole, basketball court and fire pit will be open, but everyone is asked to follow social distancing guidelines of at least 6 feet of distance maintained between people at all times. Guidelines direct us to ask you to use cloth face coverings over your nose and mouth when in public gathering areas.

- The Bath House will be open, but will have an increased cleaning and disinfecting schedule.
- The laundry room will be open, it is a small area please follow social distancing guidelines.
- Shoreline for fishing. Dock and boat ramp. Use of your canoes, kayaks, boats, etc. are all open.
- The playground is open.
- Canoe, kayak and paddle board rentals are available.
- The store is open, please be considerate of others and limit the number in the store to allow for social distancing. We will continue to take orders by phone for delivery to campsite with credit card payment or cash. Ice, firewood, kindling, etc are all available.

Your health and safety is important to us, anyone who does not comply with the campground rules or COVID-19 rules is subject to immediate ejection from the campground.
